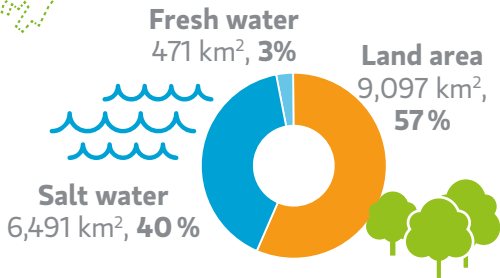
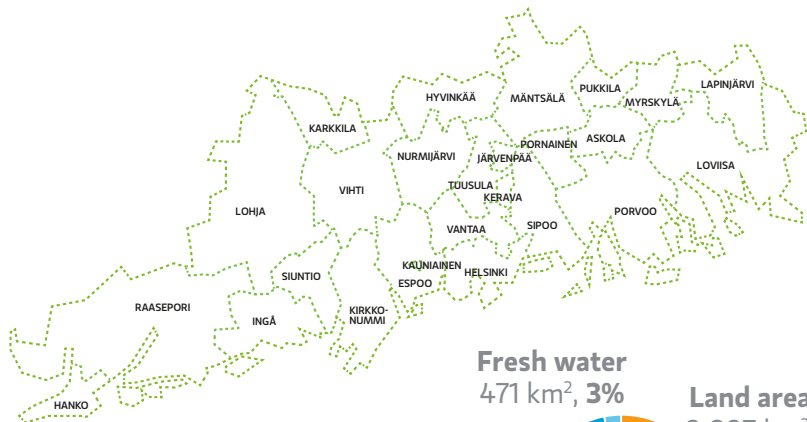


Helsinki- Uusimaa Region in Figures

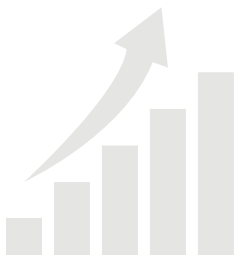

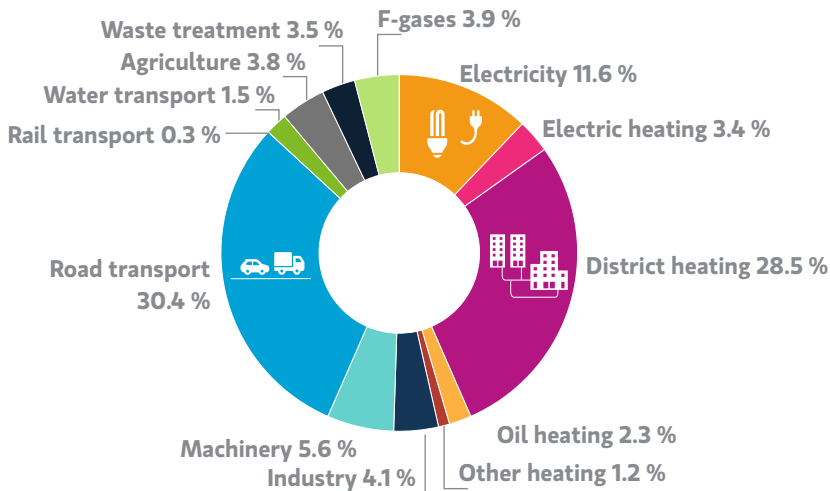
